Abbott House Survives Pandemic Stronger Than Ever

In 2021, Abbott House will serve more children and families than ever before. In just a few years, we have more than doubled the number of youth served by our Agency. In the past 18 months, we have opened three new Bridges Therapeutic homes; a boy's home in Mitchell and boy's and girl's homes in Rapid City. These homes also increased the number of apartments we have available for older youth in both communities. While it has been a crazy year filled with the stress of the pandemic, the Agency has been blessed to come through this very busy time even stronger than we were before.



The work of our staff and board have had a tremendous impact on services available in South Dakota. The investment in these children is very inexpensive compared to the impact that it will have on their lives and on society. Recently, I was out at a restaurant and ran into an alum. She wanted me to tell everyone "Hello". She is married and has her own family, which includes two children. She is working hard and in her words, she's "rockin' it"!

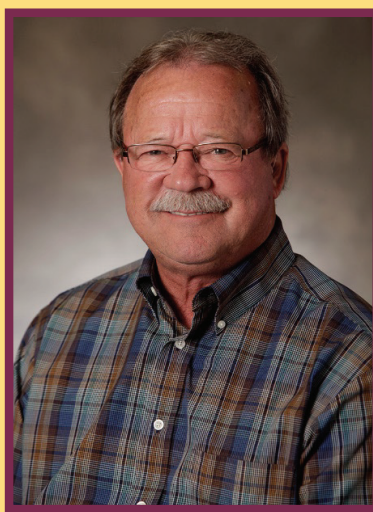

Triple Your Impact

Abbott House has seen a 30% increase in the number of youth we are serving because of the opening of three more foster homes in the past 18 months. That means 26 more young people have a home and a family, but it also means we have more youth who need your help.

Two generous donors, DeMaris Nesheim and Gopal Vyas, want to encourage others to help change children's lives by becoming Abbott House supporters. So in essence, they have "put their money where their heart is" and offered \$50,000 each in matching funding for any new or increased annual fund gift given for Abbott House children up to \$50,000. That means if you give \$50, Abbott House will get \$150; give \$100, Abbott House gets \$300, give \$100 more than you gave last year, Abbott House receives the amount you gave last year AND the matching \$300. 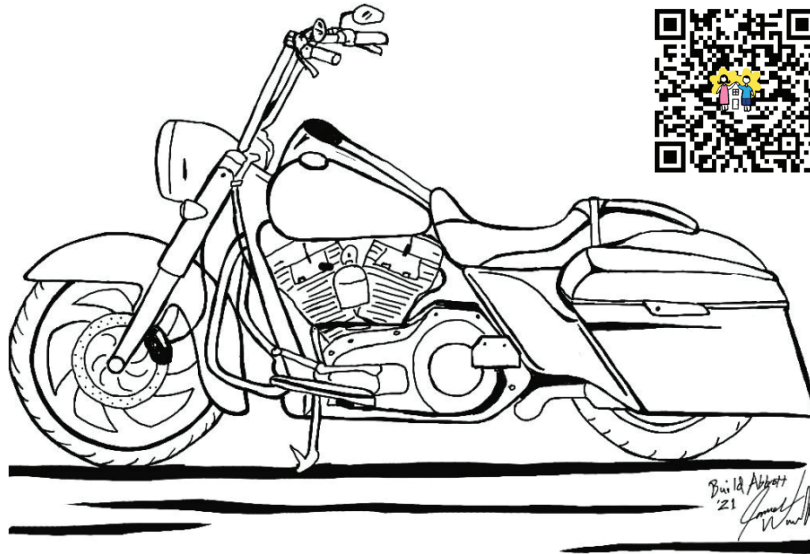


Build Abbott Bike Rebuild Program Kicks Off

Abbott House children have rebuilt five damaged motorcycles from 2011 to 2017 while rebuilding their own lives. Since then Abbott House had turned its focus towards building and rebuilding homes to provide for youth and young adults who have no safe place to live and no family to support them.

Due to the success of the past motorcycle projects and the completion of three new therapeutic foster homes, Abbott House has decided to restart the motorcycle rebuild program with the youth living in the newly established therapeutic foster homes.

This reestablished project called "Build Abbott" brings together new facilitators, Katie and James Washnok, owners of Blackout Industries, Black Hills Harley Davidson, and a new group of youth. This team of facilitators and Abbott House foster home youth meet frequently in the "shop" at Black Hills Harley Davidson to create a beautiful motorcycle with a uniqueness all its own while providing education, empowerment and encouragement.



Build Abbott is a three month classroom project giving Rapid City's Bridges by Abbott House foster children the practical, hands-on experience of repairing and customizing a motorcycle. This group will be redesigning a 2013 Harley Davidson Road King with 13,000 miles on it. They will assess the damage, take it apart and create a new paint design and a name for

the motorcycle. All of the enhancements -- paint color, individual design, new handle bars, saddle bags, exhaust and other features, and hands-on work helps our youth understand they have the power and the skills to improve the motorcycle all while improving their own lives.

This one-of-a-kind motorcycle rebuilt by foster children, will be raffled off. Tickets are \$100 each. **Only 750 tickets will be sold, so be sure to get your ticket NOW!** The winner of this bike will own a customized motorcycle designed and rebuilt by at-risk youth. 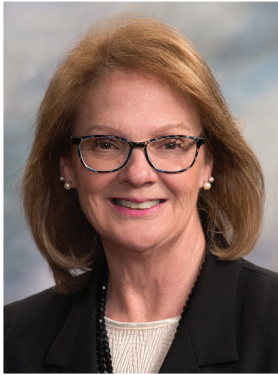

Charitable Giving Incentives Expanded in 2021

In 2021, there are even more reasons to give a gift to the Abbott House – not only can you triple any new or increased gift by participating in our matching gift program, you can also gain additional tax advantages! Most taxpayers take advantage of the standard deduction when they are filing their Federal Income Tax Returns. The Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2021 provides an additional, “above-the-line” charitable deduction on top of the standard deduction for these taxpayers.

Taxpayers who do not itemize their deductions can take a one-time deduction of up to \$300 on individual returns or \$600 on joint returns for gifts made to charity. The deduction applies ONLY for gifts of cash made in calendar year 2021.

For those who do itemize their deductions, this act also extends the charitable deduction to 100% of AGI (Adjusted Gross Income) in 2021 for individuals, and the limit from 10% to 25% of AGI for corporations.

These expanded provisions can provide incentive for potential donors to begin or increase charitable contributions to charitable organizations such as Abbott House.

Abbott House holds an official Summer Games every year! Youth compete in different games as well as a shirt design contest!

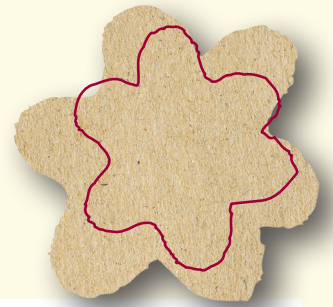

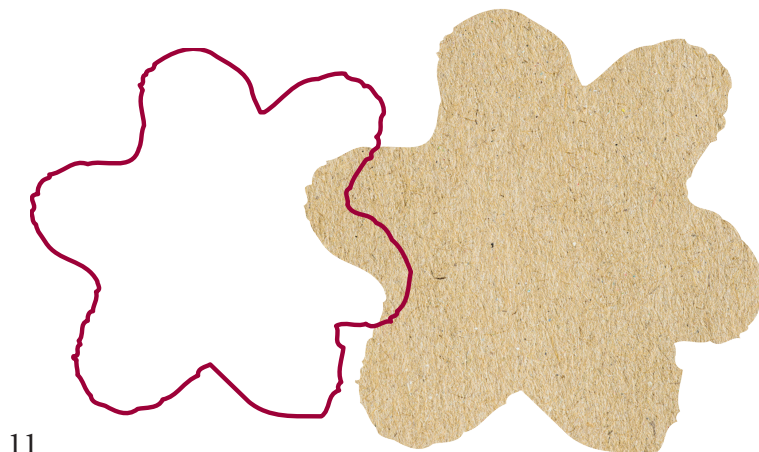

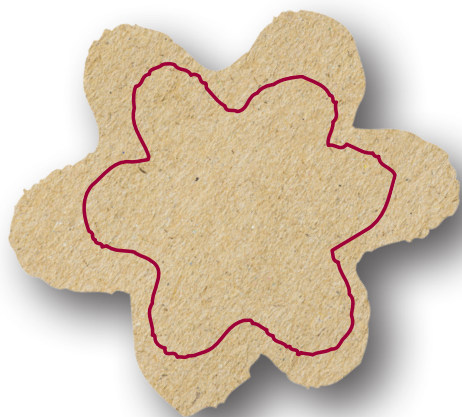
